1 Introduction

2 What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file sent by a website's server to the browser on your computer or mobile device. It may be stored on your computer or mobile device that contains data related to a website you visit. It may allow a website "remember" your actions or preferences over a period of time, or it may contain data related to the function or delivery of the site. Cookies cannot run programs or deliver viruses to your computer.

Cookies can be set by the owner of the website or in some cases by third party services the website owner allows to present other information, run content or provide other functionality such as analytics.

Cookies help us to recognise and remember your device when you visit our websites and enable us to retrieve among other things, your user settings and preferences.

3. Why do we use cookies?

We use cookies for a variety of legitimate business purposes including:

- For the operation of our website and services
- To improve your user experience. By remembering your preferences and settings we can make it easier and faster to navigate through our website
- To ensure content from our site and mobile applications is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your device.

4. How Cookies are used on this site.

www.protectoratesolutions.com and its sub-domains uses cookies for functionality that is strictly necessary for services that are explicitly requested by the user for their session as per Regulation 5(5), SI 336 of 2011 (the ePrivacy Regulations).

Functional cookies

These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalisation. They may be set by us or third-party providers. We may embed video, audio, tweets and other content in our articles and pages. We do not control which cookies are set by third parties or how the cookie information is used. If you do not allow these cookies, then some or all of these services may not function properly. Some third-party functional cookies may track your browser across other sites and build up a profile of your interests. This may impact the content and messages you see on other sites you visit.

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in or filling in forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

Performance cookies
